Mark majored in art and art history at the University of Minnesota, Morris, where he was also employed as a graphic artist. In 1997 Mark, age 20, died in a one-car accident. Mark stated, "I welcome composition in the metaphysical, the psychic automatic, the expressive, the introspective, the ambiguous, and the figurative. I am searching for composition without boundary ... It is important to me that art is explored as a function of life, life as a function of art."

This scholarship is made available through the St. Croix Valley Foundation and the Stillwater Veterans Memorial, and is provided in honor and memory of long-time Stillwater residents Jim and Joan Ratte by their four sons, all of whom graduated from Stillwater High School and were veterans of the U.S. military, along with their father Jim. The Stillwater Veterans Memorial offers a one-time \$500 cash scholarship to a Stillwater Area High School (SAHS) student who is on track to graduate high school in the spring of 2019, and who has been accepted into military service following high school graduation.
