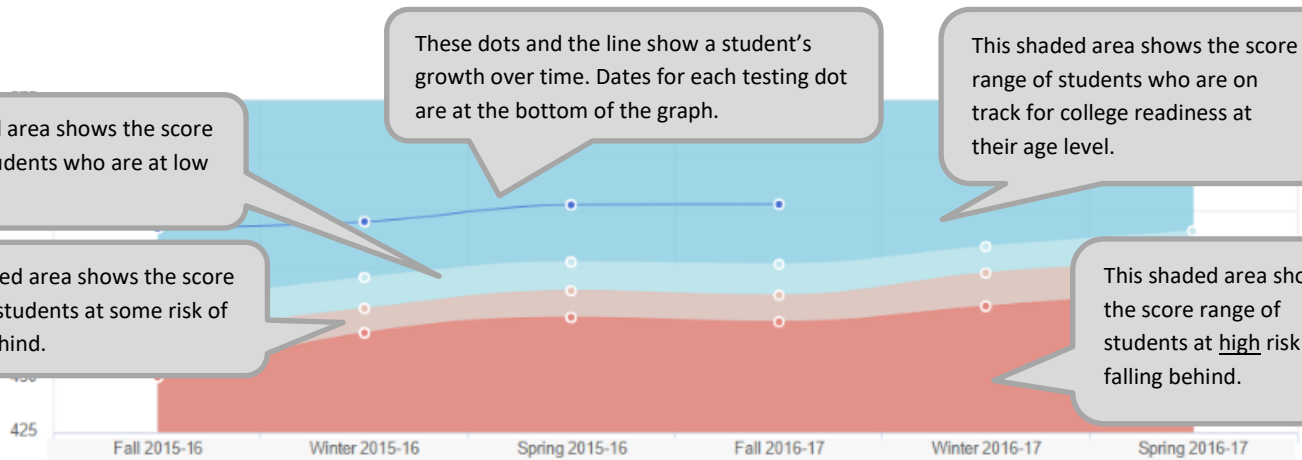




Your child's school is committed to meeting the needs of your child. In order to better identify some of those needs, our schools use the aReading and aMath test by FastBridge Learning. Below is a **sample** report to help you understand the information on your child's individual report.



This area shows the student's scores at each point in the year. No score means they were not tested during that time period.

These scores show the benchmark scores for each risk area during each testing season. Getting a "Some Risk" (!) or "High Risk" (!! ) score does not necessarily mean a student is behind. It only means that a teacher should investigate to see if that student needs extra support.

These numbers show how the student did compared to other students in their school, in their district, and in the country. Students used for comparison are in the same grade, and they took the test during the same testing season (Fall/winter/spring). *Percentile* estimates the percentage of students this student did better than on the test.

These numbers show how the student grew between testing seasons in comparison to other students with similar scores, the same grade level, and the same testing season.

*Percentiles* estimate the percentage of students this student did better than for growth.
